

5 Points of Salvation

1. Ro 3:23 For **all have sinned**, and come short of the glory of God;

Notice the word all. That means everyone, no one is perfect.

2. John 3:16 For **God so loved** the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

This verse talks about God's perfect plan to bring us back to Him. This verse also shows us that God's love for us is so great, that He does not want anyone live without Him.

3. 1Co 15:3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that **Christ died for our sins** according to the scriptures;

This verse shows us that Christ showed us that we need to obey God. Paul is writing here telling the church in Corinth and us today that what he is preaching is only what he received and not his words.

4. John 1:12 But **as many as received him**, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:
{power: or, the right, or, privilege}

Here we see that if we will accept Jesus as our Saviour we become children of God. The word many here means anyone and everyone.

5. Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and **thou shalt be saved**, and thy house.

This verse explains what happens when we believe and accept Jesus as Saviour.

Note: all the bold is mine. It is the 5 points to my message.
