

Looking for Christ

John 14:1-6

We find in verse 1 Jesus is telling His disciples and us that if we believe in God, we can believe in Him also. Now the reason Jesus says this is because God the Father and God the Son (Jesus) are one and the same. See John 1:1-2;14

Notice in verse 2 Jesus is telling His disciples and us that in His Father's house are many mansions. Now we know mansions are big fancy homes. So Jesus is saying that in heaven there will be many fancy homes for all who have accepted Christ as Saviour. Here in this same verse He is saying that He is telling the truth and if He was not telling the truth He would have told the disciples that.

Jesus tells His disciples and us in verse 3 that He will go and prepare a place for us and will come back again to receive us unto Himself, so that where He is we can be with Him forever. So here Jesus is giving us a promise that where He is right now preparing a place for us, He will come again and take us home with Him.

Verse 6 is very important for anyone that is already a Christian or someone looking to believe. Here Jesus says "I am the way, the truth, and the life; no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." So this verse is telling us that the only way to God the Father is through Jesus. There is no other person that we can believe on to get to heaven. It does not matter what you see on T.V. or hear on the radio or read in the newspaper the only way to heaven is by accepting Jesus Christ as your Saviour.

In Matthew 24:4-5 we are warned by Jesus that many will come and say that I am Christ; and will fool people. We need to know what the Bible says about God, Jesus, the rapture and what will happen in the future so that we can know when people are trying to lie to us. The only way we can know the Bible is daily study and pray for God to help us understand.
